The **SOUTH YORKSHIRE INDUSTRIAL HISTORY SOCIETY** was founded in 1933 by people from local industry and the University of Sheffield who saw that much of the area's industrial heritage was disappearing.

The Society is believed to be the world's oldest local industrial history and preservation society.

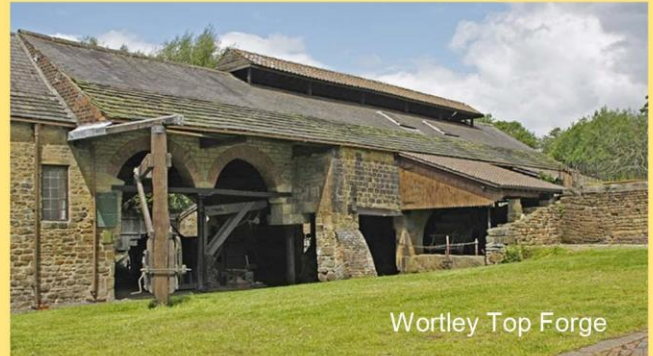


The **Society** was instrumental in the early preservation of Abbeydale Industrial Hamlet and led a successful move in 1956 to prevent the works' proposed demolition and promote their rebirth.



The **Society** owns four significant historical industrial sites -

- Bower Spring Cementation Furnaces
- Wortley Top Forge
- Hoylandswaine Nail Forge
- Rockley Furnace and Engine House



The **Society's** Field Recording Group provides an informal forum where members can meet and discuss their interests and researches.

The **Society** also comments on planning applications and is represented on Sheffield's Conservation Advisory Group.



The **Society** holds evening lectures during the winter and has a programme of events and visits in the summer
